Hamish Patrick (1946 - 2014)



In December 2014 Pilton lost a leading light with the death of Hamish Patrick. A founding member of Pilton Festival, he will be much missed. Born in London and educated in the USA, he attended the Central School of Speech and Drama and joined the Actors' Company. He did theatre work and several TV series, most notably *Crossroads* in 1978.

He moved to North Devon in 1981 and was a huge influence on

community events in Pilton. His dream was to turn the tide of communities becoming fractured when children grew up and left. He believed that a strong community bond would bring them back and 25 years later some of those children are indeed on the Festival Committee.

He directed the Green Man Pageant and organised the family friendly haven of Rotary Gardens. He adapted, directed and acted in some 20 local pantomimes and was a staunch supporter of local charities through these. He narrated beautifully an evocative video *The Myths and Legends of Exmoor* in 2003.

He got a great send off when several hundred people gathered to celebrate his life and mark his last journey down Pilton Street. And very recently the Rotary Club of Barnstaple took the previously unprecedented step of acknowledging his enormous contribution to Pilton life with its annual Citizen of the Year Award.

Hamish Patrick - a much loved man greatly missed.

FESTIVAL DAY BEGINS

Up with the lark are the festival committee and their helpers to set up Pilton Street, Rotary Garden and the Stages. Bins to put out, marquees to erect, participants to be directed to their positions for the day. Bacon butties and a mug of tea wouldn't go amiss!

THE PROCESSION

The Procession starts from Barnstaple Square at 10.45am and makes its way along the High Street, then Pilton Causeway and processes up Pilton Street, turning right into Pilton House Grounds. Look for the large Red and Green Masks leading the way!

THE PAGEANT

(Pilton House Grounds 12 noon and 3pm)

The Green Man is an ancient Pagan symbol of nature and fertility frequently depicted in carvings in old churches as a face sprouting foliage. A splendid green man carving can be seen in St Mary the Virgin Church in Pilton.

The Prior of the Benedictine Priory of Pilton lived at The Bull House below the Church until the reformation. The ritual enacted at Pilton Festival is believed to represent the initial antagonism of two characters, Prior and Green Man, represented by Red and Green Masks and the subsequent inclusion of the pagan figure within the church. Under the direction of Bev Neighbour, it takes place on the lawn in front of Pilton House at 12 noon and again at 3pm.

Pilton Street &

Central to Green Man Day is Pilton Street, with the hustle and bustle amongst the stalls, the arrival of the procession and a day of music from the three stages.

In recent years, festivities have expanded in to the comfort of Rotary Gardens, a splendid setting for family-based activities with children's soft-play and free-play areas and a hand-cranked Victorian merry-go-round.





Dotted amongst the trees, arts and craftsmen will demonstrate their skills and local interest groups and charities will 'set out their stalls'. The enchanting interactive family friendly storytellers Entertainingly Different will be performing throughout


