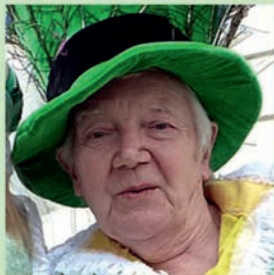

Albert Linacre (1930 - 2015)



In September 2015 Pilton lost a key figure with the passing of Albert Linacre. Albert spent the last 35 years of a very full life in Pilton, loved and admired by all. Born in Birmingham in 1930, he went to school in Edinburgh and, after national service, began a successful career in catering management. He married Maggie in the late 1960s, and they moved from London in 1977 and bought a shop and house in Pilton Street. Maggie ran the wholefood shop and

coffee bar, while Albert went to North Devon College to teach the art of catering.

In 1982 the first Pilton Festival took place and Albert, closely involved in its organisation, started making costumes. When the first Green Man Day was held in 1995 Albert, with the help of his sewing ladies, made the distinctive costumes which characterise the event to this day. He was quite simply the one person who kept the ball rolling and inspired others, making Pilton what it is today – a really vibrant community. Without Albert, Pilton Green Man Day would not be the wonderful, magical spectacle it is and a fitting way to remember him each year.

Laurie Wedge (1953 - 2016)

Laurie Wedge, the Green Man on stilts, died aged 63, in February 2016. Many people saw and enjoyed his 15 year involvement in the Festival. No-one could miss his giraffe-like walk through the crowd, ten-feet tall in a spectacular plant and flower costume, sprinkling rose petals and offering a green blessing. "Pilton Festival, was the highlight of his year," said his partner, Teresa Price.

"It's what he believed in. He spent a lot of time preparing for it, arranging his costume and collecting rose petals."

Laurie came from London where he learned stiltwalking with Abi Falkner, with whom he had two children. Abi said, "He really was a very authentic and appropriate choice, as he loved nature, gardening and growing things. His London garden was absolutely bursting with plants, from a huge wild cherry to small bonsai trees. Every window sill was chockablock with plants grown from seed, lemon plants, passion flowers, pine cuttings and all sorts." Even when ill, Laurie insisted on appearing in the Festival because of his friends and his kinship with the spirit of the occasion.

Dave Butt (1953 - 2016)



Pilton has lost a gifted community leader with the death of Dave Butt. Dave was Assistant Headteacher at Braunton Academy until 2010, a Barnstaple Town and then North Devon District Councillor and Honorary Alderman and a leading player in the Pilton community. He contributed enormously to the world of rugby, was Chairman of Devon RFU, and was closely involved in the 2015 World Cup. He was a huge supporter of the Barnstaple-based charity Amigos Worldwide, and

worked as a volunteer for Children's Hospice South West. Although he had stepped down from formal public duty in recent years, Dave was still very much involved in North Devon Theatres and Museum. Pilton will be a poorer place for his loss. Among his legacies is a stronger Green Man Festival where his ability to bring people together and get things to happen resulted in the growing involvement of the next generation willing to help the community come together. His will be difficult shoes to fill but he surely did much to inspire people to pick up where, sadly, he has left off.

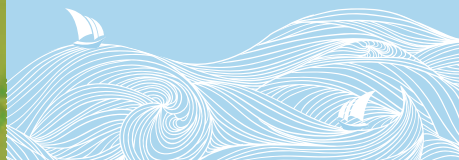

FESTIVAL DAY BEGINS

Up with the lark are the committee and their helpers to set up Pilton Street, Rotary Gardens and the stages. Bins to put out, marquees to erect, participants to be directed to their positions for the day.

THE PROCESSION

The Procession begins at Barnstaple Square at 11.00am and makes its way along the High Street and Pilton Causeway to arrive at the bottom of Pilton Street by 11.30am. Processing up the street and turning into Pilton House Grounds . Look out for the large Green and Red Mask leading the way.

THE PAGEANT

(Pilton House Grounds 12 noon and 3pm)

The Green Man is an ancient Pagan symbol of nature and fertility frequently depicted in carvings in old churches as a face sprouting foliage. A splendid green man carving can be seen in St Mary the Virgin Church in Pilton.

The Prior of the Benedictine Priory of Pilton lived at The Bull House below the Church until the reformation. The ritual enacted at Pilton Festival is believed to represent the initial antagonism of two characters, Prior and Green Man, represented by Red and Green Masks and the subsequent inclusion of the pagan figure within the church. Under the direction of Bev Neighbour, it takes place on the lawn in front of Pilton House at 12 noon and again at 3pm.

Pilton Street &

Central to Green Man Day is Pilton Street, with the hustle and bustle amongst the stalls, the arrival of the procession and a day of music from the three stages.

In recent years, festivities have expanded in to the comfort of Rotary Gardens, a splendid setting for family-based activities with children's soft-play and free-play areas and a hand-cranked Victorian merry-go-round.



Dotted amongst the trees, arts and craftsmen will demonstrate their skills and local interest groups and charities will 'set out their stalls'. The enchanting interactive family friendly story-tellers Entertainingly Different will be performing throughout

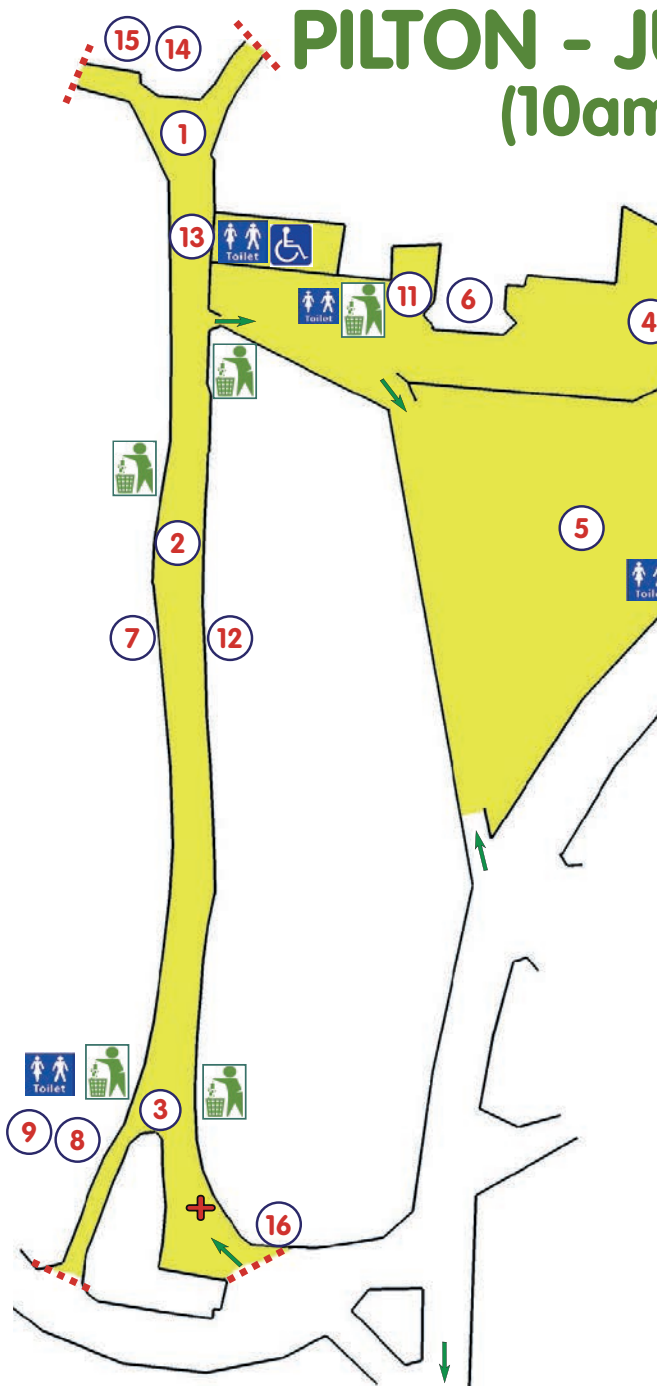

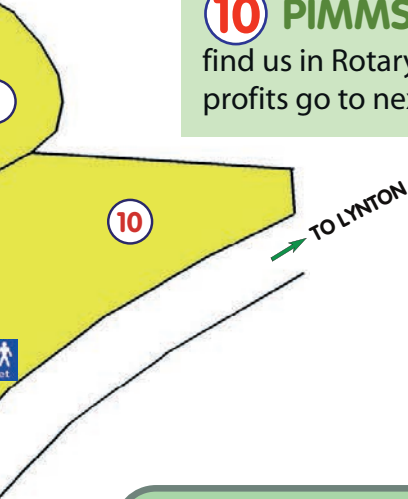
